



## **ingridscience workshop COVID-19 operating plan**

I bring workshops into school classrooms if approved by the school administration. Otherwise my workshops are outdoors.

I follow BC Provincial Health guidelines and any additional recommendations of the local Medical Health Officer.

I have been double vaccinated for COVID-19 (second vaccination on June 22nd 2021).

### **The day of the workshop**

- I perform a health check. If I have any symptoms of COVID-19, or any respiratory illness, I will cancel the workshop, and proceed as advised by Provincial Health (Ref.1, p.13; Ref.2, p.15).
- I sign in at the office whether the workshop is indoors or outdoors (Ref.1, p.11; Ref.2, p.15).

### **During the workshop**

- I only enter a school building if invited by school staff.
- I wash my hands before a workshop. If a sink is not available, I use hand sanitizer (Ref.1, p.15; Ref.2, p.17).
- I wear a non-medical mask while indoors (Ref.1, p.16; Ref.2, p.20), and also at outdoor workshops if it aligns with the culture of the school.
- I strive to keep my distance from students except when we are studying the same materials closely. I keep those close encounters as brief as possible.

### **Preparing and packing workshop materials**

- I wash my hands before packing materials for a workshop.
- Hard-surface materials that have been previously touched are cleaned with soap and water, and if necessary, disinfected with 0.5% hydrogen peroxide, before packing (Ref. 1, p.9; Ref. 2, p.12; Ref. 3).
